

## ARA METFORMIN INFORMATION POLICY

Dear Patient,

You have had an imaging examination today that involved IV Contrast (x-ray dye). If you are taking one of the diabetic medications listed below, you are **NOT** to take the medication for 48 hours after the examination without first consulting your physician.

<b>Actos Plus Met</b>	<b>Glucophage XR</b>	<b>Metformin</b>
<b>Advandamet</b>	<b>Glyburide-Metformin</b>	<b>Metformin ER</b>

<b>Glumetza</b>	<b>Glipizide/Metformin</b>	
<b>Rosiglitazone/Metformin</b>	<b>Kombiglyze XR/Saxagliptin-metformin</b>	

You will need to call the physician who prescribed the medication and inform him/her that you have had IV contrast (x-ray dye). Your physician may want to add an additional test before you resume your medication. The physician who prescribed the medication can be found on your pharmacy prescription label.
